White polo top or shirt

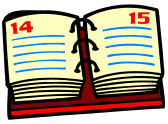
## Bronze Judo medals for Lucy and Sallyna

Lucy Lucas (Mayflower) and Sallyna Do (Calypso) represented Southwark last Saturday in the London Youth Games.

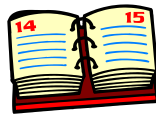
We are very pleased to announce that they both won bronze medals in the under 12 judo competition.
