

# RPS School Development Plan 2017/2018

## Outcomes for pupils

To increase the % of pupils achieving Greater Depth in KS1 and KS2 to be in line with Nat Av

Establish a reading culture across the school resulting in improved standards and progress

To improve progress in Maths and ensure at least 75% - 85% of pupils across the school are at age related expectations.

To raise standards in Maths by reinforcing knowledge of number and mathematical skills of reasoning and problem solving

Continue to improve outcomes of writing across the schools by embedding 'Dramatic Progress in Literacy' programme

Ensure that the % of pupils reaching GLDs in the Early Years is at least in line with National expectations (70%)

Continue to ensure good or better progress for all pupils to ensure we diminish the differences between different groups especially Pupil Premium and those on SEND

## Quality of Teaching, Learning & Assessment

Ensure that the quality of teaching and learning is 100% good or outstanding

Develop consistency of precision of feedback enabling pupils to make improvements to their work

Ensure challenge for all pupils lead to good or better progress

Ensure science is effectively taught across KS1 and KS2

Maximising the impact of support staff across the school to ensure good and better progress for all pupils.

Refine assessment procedures and systems to support accurate tracking of pupils' progress and standards which can be analysed for further improvement.

Improve the computing provision across the school.

To support the improvements in writing, embed 'editing' as a core skill in teachers training

## Effectiveness of Leadership and Management

To continue to strengthen leadership at all levels; senior leadership, middle leadership, subject leaders and Gobs

Middle leaders to take greater accountability and responsibility for moderation and assessment for subject areas

To provide effective and timely CPD to all staff and ensure quality first teaching in every class

Continue to effectively monitor on the quality of Teaching and Learning across the school and implement effective strategies to improve areas of weakness

To further develop strong and targeted parental involvement with parents

Ensure effective safeguarding procedures are in place

Ensure a relevant, appropriate and effective curriculum for all pupils taking into account their learning needs and interests.

To improve P.E. provision across the school, ensuring that curriculum objectives are met.

## Personal Development, Behaviour and Welfare

To continue to provide opportunities to develop children's mental wellbeing, self-esteem and resilience.

To continue to promote our strong set of school values which prepares children for modern Britain and becoming global citizens.

Continue to provide effective welfare provision to ensure pupils are safeguarded

Raise awareness and tackle any form of bullying and further develop awareness and understanding of homophobia and gender identity.
