On line safety

The internet is amazing. Children can play, learn, create and connect - opening up a whole world of exciting possibilities. But with the digital world changing all the time, are you making sure your children are staying safe online?

Keeping our children safe is of paramount importance to us, so we are alarmed when we hear of children **illegally** accessing apps and leaving themselves open to communication from strangers and to online bullying.

We are increasingly dealing with issues of this nature.

Apps that are currently popular, such as Whats app, musical. ly, Instagram and Snapchat to name just a few are, have a minimum age use of 13 years. So children should not be using them.

Any programmes that children use should be carefully monitored by parents.

Privacy settings should always be used to prevent strangers contacting your children.
