'that was the best prom ever!'



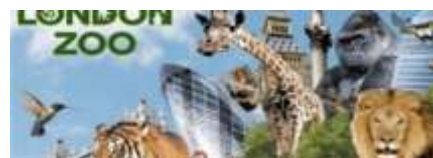
