Have you identified the problem in your story? If not, can you imagine what the problem might be?

#### **Activity**

Write down the problem in the story and how you think the problem might be solved. Can you draw a picture to go with your explanation?

15 - 20 mins **Reading** 

Read the next section of your book. How was the problem resolved? Did the book end in the way you expected?

#### Activity

Compare the ending of the story with your prediction at the start of the week. What was the same? What was different?

	Look at the cover of the book. What do you think the book is about? Do the pictures give you any clues? If the book has a blurb at the back, what does this tell you about the story?  Activity Make a prediction about what will happen in the book. Read the first chapter or first few pages. Was your prediction correct? Draw a picture to describe what happens at the beginning of the story.
