Scaled scores for KS2 SATS provide a way to convert raw scores (the number of marks achieved) into a standard score, allowing for comparisons over time. A scaled score of **100 or more** means a child has **met the expected standard** for their age, while a score below 100 indicates they have not yet reached it. The possible range for KS2 scaled scores is 80 to 120.
