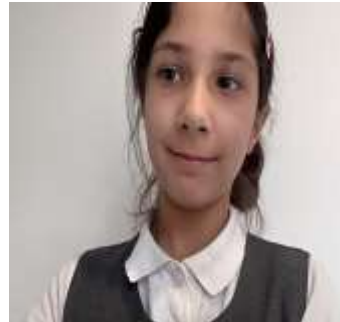
“We have been learning to create a symmetrical abstract art form. We have been inspired by ‘Hermann Rarschach’ by Andy Warhol “
