

This year we will cover a range of texts including poetry, fiction and non fiction. Children will also be having handwriting, grammar and spelling lessons every week.

How can you help?

–Help your child to learn their weekly spellings and the statutory spellings for their year group

–Encourage your child to practise their handwriting <u>using the</u> <u>cursive style</u>

Handwriting

Children are expected to be joining using the cursive style. There are a few key things to remember:



Start from the bottom of the line and sweep up to form the first letter. Saying 'up the hill' will help children remember this!

When joining, do not take the pen or pencil off the page until the whole word is completed! When it is finished, go back and cross and dot where needed.

When the word is finished, flick out the last letter as if you were going to continue joining.

<u>The cursive alphabet</u>

abcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz

When joined, it looks like this...

The quick brown fox jumps over the lazy dog.



How can you help?



–Read every night with your child asking them questions about what they have read.

–Your child must bring their reading journal to school <u>every day</u>

–Encourage children to read a range of texts/genres. Examples: newspapers, poetry, magazines, internet, books.

–Encourage children to use their journals to write about their reading. There is prompt sheet at the back of their journals to support with asking questions.





How can you help?

-Help your child to learn their times tables

-Measurement conversions

-Money

-Learning to tell the time (analogue & digital, 12 hour and 24 hour)

The pupil and parent dashboard helps you to engage with your child's learning experience.




