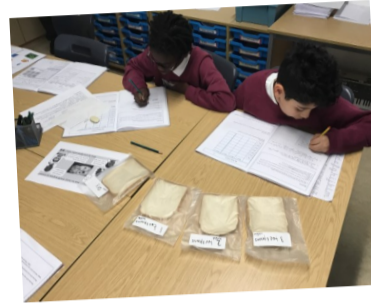

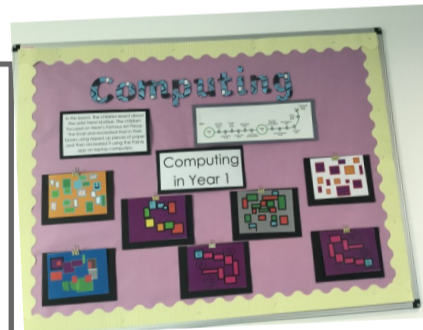
Science
