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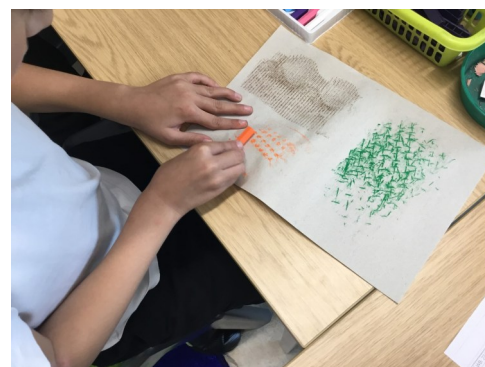
Gardening

Year 3 children, have learnt a new technique (frottage) which is when rubbing is taken from textured surfaces to form the basis of a work of art.

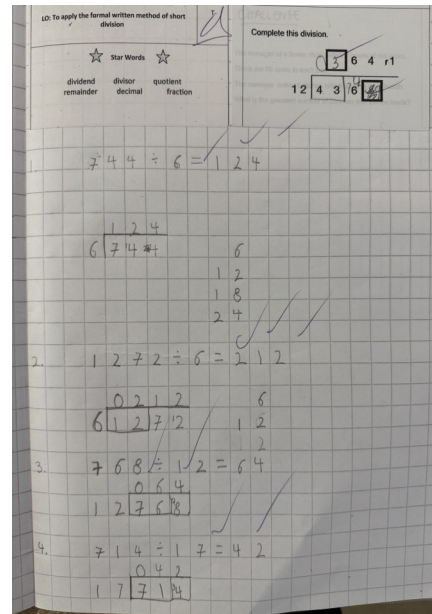




Mathematics
